The objective of this assignment is to ensure that the installation carried out under the SSEP Component 2 are implemented professionally, to the required specifications and timelines the Consultant shall therefore be responsible for technical support for the procurement process and site supervision of these installations on behalf of SED as Engineer, review technical specification documents, sampling, testing & commissioning of equipment to ensure that all contractual obligations are met.

(ii) They should have successfully completed at least two assignments of similar scale and complexity, out of which at least one assignment has involved renewable energy of similar scale and complexity (iii) Management capacity of the firm including general availability of technical and managerial qualified staff


case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
